

I am writing to you not as Senators, Congressman, Judiciary members (Judges and Attorneys), President, First Lady and Others; but, as citizens of the United States.

Attached is a CD with a rough copy of my TRUE STORY of how the State of Connecticut violates citizens Constitutional rights blatantly without consideration of DUE PROCESS of the LAW or Supreme Court Precedents for Parents Constitutional rights!

That's right there are millions of parents that have been separated from children without cause like myself!

This CD consisted of a 27 page synopsis of the almost 40 year violation of parental rights that is still going on today; along with about 280 pages of court and other supporting documentation that clearly shows the blatant violations.

Attached are letters between Congressman Chris Gibson's and U.S. Attorney Daly's Office.

US Attorney for the District of Connecticut The Honorable Deirdre M. Daly is in charge of a public corruption task force (Feds, struck by "persistent" criminal behavior by public officials in Connecticut, create an anti-corruption task force (Hartford Courant February 4, 2015))

On June 16, 2016, Ann Mueller of Congressman Chris Gibson's office told me over the phone that the Congressman's Office could not make U.S. Attorney Daly reply to the January 25, 2016 request. **Since Congressman Chris Gibson has decided not to run for Congress again, I would have to wait until another Congressman was elected to help me.**

The State of Connecticut now states that I now owe the full amount of the child support because they lost their documentation Please see pages 21 and 22, I have my paperwork; (corruption at its worse). How can I owe when there was no DUE PROCESS even when it was court ordered (see page 6 in 1986) and the State refused to do the custody study which is the DUE PROCESS!?

After you read this I hope you understand how the State of Connecticut put my children in severe jeopardy (especially Steven, he was given back to his mother the day she was deemed unfit by another Connecticut agency)!

Parents do matter and experts say (Doctors, sociologist etc....) children in Foster Care are mostly angry at the system because they were taken from their parents; and it is not healthy for either the child or the parent! Yet, States like Connecticut have been violating parents' rights and it has been going on for decades even though there have been many Court rulings stating that DUE PROCESS is required.

I find it appalling that the only Constitutional Amendment being argued is the 2nd, about guns, when the Supreme Court has ruled:

The Constitution also protects "the individual interest in avoiding disclosure of personal matters." Federal Courts (and State Courts), under Griswold can protect, under the "life, liberty and pursuit of happiness" phrase of the Declaration of Independence, the right of a man to enjoy the mutual care, company, love and affection of his children, and this cannot be taken away from him without due process of law. There is a family right to privacy which the state cannot invade

or it becomes actionable for civil rights damages. **Griswold v. Connecticut, 381 US 479, (1965).**

No bond is more precious and none should be more zealously protected by the law as the bond between parent and child.” Carson v. Elrod, 411 F Supp 645, 649; DC E.D. VA (1976).

“One of the most precious rights possessed by parents is the right to raise their children free of government interference. That right, "more precious than mere property rights," is a liberty interest, protected by the substantive and procedural Due Process Clauses of the Fourteenth Amendment. Stanley v. Illinois, 405 U.S. 645, 92 S.Ct. 1208, 31 L.Ed.2d 551 (1972).”

You would think Parenthood would be more important than gun ownership!

I am looking for justice and as citizens of the United States I hope you will understand this; but, as Senators, Congressman, Judiciary members (Judges and Attorneys), President, First Lady and Others I am hoping that you bring this to light and stop the destruction of the family unit!

I would like to die a FREE man not on a Deadbeat List that I have never belonged on in the first place and like Griswold v. Connecticut states: **There is a family right to privacy which the state cannot invade or it becomes actionable for civil rights damages. Griswold v. Connecticut, 381 US 479, (1965).** I believe that the State of Connecticut owes my family for their blatant violations of my family.
