Max,

It has been about a month since we spoke at the CANTINE MEMORIAL FIELD, Pavilion St. Saugerties and I sent you additional information about my issue with the State of Connecticut and I have not heard back from you.

I would like to know if you and Congressman Delgado are willing to write a letter on my behalf to the U.S. Attorney's Office to explain that their Actions that were taken against the State of Connecticut from 2013 through 2015 fell short of correcting the corrupt policies of the State's Child Enforcement or the Child Support Enforcement. My case shows this.

The State of Connecticut has been taken 10% of my Social Security because of the corruption within the State's Child Enforcement or the Child Support Enforcement that the U.S. Attorney's Office said they addressed in 2015 when I was told by Congressman Chris Gibson Office which I sent you the correspondence.

Another letter that I think would be appropriate would be a letter from your Office to the Connecticut Attorney General's Office asking why it has taken so long to respond to the Whistleblower Complaint that was forwarded to them from Maura F. Pardo, Administrative Auditor Auditors of Public Accounts State of Connecticut on 10/23/2020.
