This complaint is about how the State of Connecticut is taking children without a custody study or any investigation and then falsifying payment records so people cannot pay them off much like Organized Crime.

I sent a complaint to your office in 2015 through Ex-Congressman Gibson's office. I do not have a copy of the 2015 complaint but it was supposed have been given to Assistant US Attorney Jennifer R. Laraia even though Assistant US Attorney Deirdre M. Daly was working on this issue at that time.

I have recently been writing letters/complaints to The President, Senators, Congress-people, the Connecticut Governor and Lt. Governor, other CT Representatives and the Media seeking help in this matter and I am filing this complaint with most of them. Copies of these complaints/letters are linked all to a website, the address of this website is within these letters which tells the story from 1978 when my children were taken and again in 1986 (same children) when they were taken for the final time. Violating a Connecticut Supreme Court Judge's Order.

Attached is:

1) The Letter to Investigative Reporters that shows the State of Connecticut has been investigated for these same charges at other times, with news releases. The State is still acting like an Organized Crime system, nothing has changed in the way the State treats Parents.

2) A letter to President Trump: In this letter I told him that "When the children were taken away from their parents at the border and people all over the United States were saying that never happens here in the U.S. They were wrong This has happened to me and many others!" 5) A letter to Connecticut Lt Governor Susan Bysiewicz: This asks questions that were never answered about the Payment Records (VIA- Adam Joseph adam.joseph@ct.gov e-mailed Oct. 2, 2019). Still no response.

6) Letter to the Office of Connecticut Governor Ned Lamont: The Head of State Government is the Governor and he or she should be aware of the Corruption and put an end to it. I have spoke with several Ct. Governors and they refused to look into this Corruption. This Governor seems to be the same way, because there has been no response.
