Arguments concerning dismantling the FDA

Supposed advantages (highly disputed):

- **Increased toxic exposure:** The EPA's Integrated Risk Information System (IRIS) program evaluates the human health effects of exposure to toxic chemicals. Eliminating this program would remove the scientific basis for limiting dangerous chemical exposure, increasing the risk of cancer, developmental problems, and other health issues.
- **Exacerbated environmental inequities:** Historically, low-income and minority communities have faced disproportionate exposure to environmental toxins. Weakening EPA safeguards would worsen these inequities and increase health disparities.

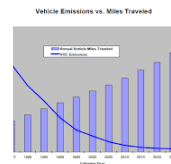
Conclusion

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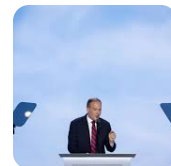
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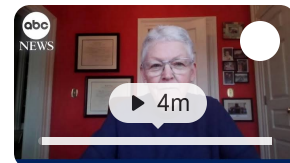
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
