- **Disproportionate harm to vulnerable communities:** Without EPA enforcement, low-income and minority communities that are already disproportionately affected by pollution would face even greater environmental health burdens.
- **Undermined scientific research:** The EPA's scientific research is crucial for understanding and addressing environmental and public health risks. Eliminating the agency would stifle this research, making it harder to prepare for and respond to future environmental and health challenges.

Counterarguments often cited by critics of the FDA and EPA

Arguments for rolling back regulations or dismantling agencies like the FDA and EPA generally center on economic benefits rather than direct improvements to human health. These arguments include:

- **Reducing costs and boosting productivity:** Industries would no longer have to spend money on compliance, potentially leading to lower production costs and higher profits.
- **Accelerating product development:** Less regulation on pharmaceuticals and medical devices could theoretically speed up the time it takes for new products to reach the market.
- **Encouraging innovation:** Some argue that a less-regulated environment fosters faster innovation, though others argue that a stable regulatory environment drives predictable, science-based innovation.

However, these claimed economic gains are highly contested, with many studies finding that the health benefits of regulation, such as reduced illness and increased productivity, outweigh the costs.

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
