- **Increasing rates:** Cancer rates, particularly among younger women, are on the rise. One source notes a 1.4% annual increase since 2021, while another indicates a 2.51% annual increase for women aged 20-29 in the last two decades, [say sources](#).
- **Risk factors:** Key risk factors include increasing age, obesity, harmful alcohol use, and family history, but many women diagnosed with breast cancer do not have a known family history.

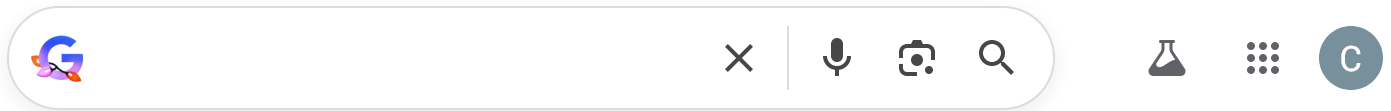

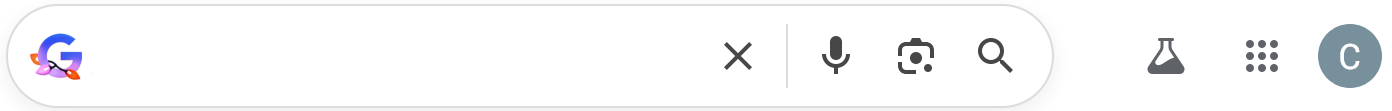
